Parts of a Book

Title: The name of the book.

Cover: Front of the book.

Author: The person who wrote the book.

Illustrator: The person who drew the pictures in the book.



Parts of a Book Vocabulary:

1. Book title – the name of the book.
2. Author – the person who wrote the book.
3. Illustrator - the person who drew the pictures or illustrations in the book.
4. Front Cover – the front of the book.
5. Spine – it holds the book together.
6. Title Page – it gives the title, author or authors, other people that were important in the production of the book (editor, illustrators) along with the publisher and city, date.
7. Back Cover – the back of the book.
8. Table of Contents – a list that shows the pages and names of the book's chapters or parts in the order in which they appear by page numbers.
9. Index – a listing of names, places, and subjects discussed in the book with page numbers.
10. Glossary – an alphabetical list of words in the book and their definitions.
11. Dedication – a listing of who the book was dedicated to or written for.
12. Copyright Page – tells the owner/publisher and year of registration with the government.
13. Publisher – the person or company that prepared or issued the book for sale.
